### **Applications for Sports Council (SC) Funding:**

This year this funding was delegated to CCC for selection. £2000 available, only to Cave Rescue Organisations.

2 applications received:

- West Brecon Cave Rescue Team (WBCRT)

- North Wales Cave Rescue Organisation (NWCRO)

GE spoke on behalf of WBCRT and DL (previous member of NWCRO) spoke on behalf of NWCRO

Committee looked at application forms, discussed various aspects of each application and considered aspects such as no. of callouts, area covered, needs and financial status of each organisation etc.

Decided by vote that WBCRT will receive \$1200 and NWCRO will receive £800 CO – we can allocate money immediately and report to SC.

GE – noted that SC have effectively reduced funding by a third this year and the grant money is not enough – WBCRT will write to SC.

CO – will write letter to SC saying CCC would have allocated more money if it was available.

# **CCC** Newsletter:

Discussion on whether to maintain a CCC Newsletter now that BCA are producing one and the CCC website is to be updated and launched.

Decided not to produce a regular Newsletter as latest news can be posted on website. AGM & General Meeting Mins still to be posted to clubs.

Possible occasional 'Newsletter' on back of flyers for special events/AGM Mins Send out a 'last' Newsletter announcing new website – once this is up and running.

# **CCC Library and Archives:**

GE had contacted the National Library of Wales Aberystwyth who had agreed to store the CCC's Library collection (Club Journals etc.)- they would then own it but would notify CCC if wanting to get rid of it.

# Training

### **Conservation:**

OC would like help making a ladder for Draenen. Already has raw materials (already paid for by CCC). Needs manufacturing equip.

SWCC has required workshop and equip.

SM to contact SWCC members to seek help with project

No insurance liability for ladders by CCC as will be covered by Draenen Committee

### **Constitution:**

Needs to be changed to take into account controlling access on behalf of other orgs. Already covered on insurance.
