Annual Report for the Cambrian Caving Council's AGM.

2014 has been our quietest year on record, with only one recorded incident:

On the 22nd April a party of nine cavers from Leeds University were reported to be overdue from their trip into Agen Allwedd. Before a search team had been dispatched, two members of the missing party exited the cave, informing the rescue team that the party had become severely lost and the remaining seven cavers could be found in Biza Passage. After 18 hours and involving 22 team members, the overdue party were escorted from the cave via Southern Stream Passage.
